For ten years, the ULS and the Office of Undergraduate Research (OUR) have partnered to make possible an undergraduate research experience based in the ULS's distinctive collections. These collections include archives, manuscripts, music, rare books, and other unique items such as handwritten letters from George Washington, August Wilson playbills, props from modern horror films, and everything in between.

Awardees receive a stipend to develop their research and get specialized mentorship from a faculty member and a librarian.

In spring 2025, awardees will collaborate on a digital interactive wall exhibit to showcase their research projects.
